- **Fashion Show** – enrolled in any Clothing/Textiles or Consumer Management Project: Sewing for Fun, Clothing 1, Clothing 2, Sewing For You, Tailoring, Decorated Your Duds, Knitting, Crocheting, Attention Shoppers!, Shopping in Style.
- **Food Revue** – enrolled in any of these Food & Nutrition Projects: Six Easy Bites, Tasty Tidbits, Meals, Fast Foods, You're the Chef, Foodworks, Food Preservation, Be An Ar-Cake-Techt, Youth in Motion or the Junior Clover project – Road to Good Cooking.
- **Shooting Sports Lessons and Event** – enrolled in one of the following projects: Archery, Trap, BB Gun, Air Rifle or Air Pistol
