

FASHION SHOW

General Fashion Show Rules:

- A. Fashion Show entry forms & written narratives – Forms are due in the Extension Office by the appropriate deadline date, see Deadlines, Dates and Identifications. All garments in the Fashion Show MUST also be judged in construction.
- B. Limits – Members may model in five different classes, must be enrolled in correct project. Sewing For You project members are limited to two (2) Sewing For You exhibits.
- C. **Night shirts, flannel lounging pants or loungewear** can only be modeled in Class 908 – Modeling For Fun.
- D. Top Modeling Awards – 4-H'ers receiving must be present at the Public Fashion Show to receive their award.
- E. All Grand and Reserve Champions must be a Purple ribbon winner.
- F. In regards to Classes C410020 thru C410100 - Clothing II, Sewing for You, or Tailoring the entry must be a complete, wearable outfit except if entry is a non-tailored coat, or outerwear jacket. Garments should be age appropriate.
- G. 4-H members who have enrolled in or completed Challenging Patterns, Challenging Fabrics, Sewing for You, and/or Tailoring are not eligible to compete in Clothing Level 2.
- H. Sewing For Fun participants will only be allowed to model at the Public Fashion Show, they will receive a Multi-color and premium only for their participation in the show. They may not model pin cushions or needle books.
- I. Junior Clovers may model "FCS Workshop Item" in Jr Clover Modeling. They will only receive a Junior Clover ribbon and NO premium. Junior Clovers are ages 5 – 7.
- J. State Fair Eligibility – 4-H'ers must be 12 years or older as of January 1st of current year for Shopping in Style, 4-H'ers must be 10 years or older as of January 1st for all other Fashion Show classes.

- C410010 DECORATE YOUR DUDS – Garment constructed from Original Designed Fabric. Fabric is made first, then a garment is constructed from the fabric. Examples include: painting on fabric, color discharge, shibori, tie dyeing, weaving fabric strips, crazy piecing and paper piecing, and color blocking fabric pieces. Other embellishment may be added. Embellished garments with original design entries should be exhibited in C4100901.
- C4100901 EMBELLISHED DUDS – Embellished garment or embellished garment with original design. Must be a garment not just an accessory.
- C410020 CLOTHING LEVEL 2 – A purchased top can be worn to complete a vest or jacket outfit with a skirt, pants or shorts. Possible types of garments include dress; skirted outfit – skirt with shirt, vest or jacket; jumper and shirt; or pant outfit – pants or shorts with shirt, vest or jacket. **Night shirts, flannel lounging pants or loungewear cannot be modeled.** However, if there is only one constructed garment and it needs another piece or more to be complete it **must** be entered in Make One/Buy One. 4-H members who have enrolled in or completed Sewing for You, and/or Tailoring are not eligible.
- C410030 DRESS – (Sewing For You)
- C410040 SKIRT OUTFIT OR JUMPER WITH TOP – (Sewing For You) If two pieces need a top to complete the outfit it is not necessary to have constructed the top. The outfit must be a complete wearable outfit. However, if there is only one constructed garment and it needs another piece or more to be complete it **must** be entered in Make One/Buy One.
- C410050 FORMALS and TUXEDO– (Sewing For You) If two pieces need a top to complete the outfit it is not necessary to have constructed the top. The outfit must be a complete wearable outfit. However, if there is only one constructed garment and it needs another piece or more to be complete it **must** be entered in Make One/Buy One.
- C410060 PANT OUTFIT – (Sewing For You) If two pieces need a top to complete the outfit it is not necessary to have constructed the top. The outfit must be a complete wearable outfit. **Night shirts, flannel lounging pants or loungewear cannot be modeled.** However, if there is only one constructed garment and it needs another piece or more to be complete it **must** be entered in Make One/Buy One.
- C410070 SPECIALTY WEAR – including Costumes (no nightwear or loungewear) - (Sewing For You) If two pieces need a top to complete the outfit it is not necessary to have constructed the top. The outfit must be a complete wearable outfit. However, if there is only one constructed garment and it needs another piece or more to be complete it **must** be entered in Make One/Buy One.
- C410080 SPORTSWEAR – including jogging outfit, swim wear, aerobic wear and ski wear - (Sewing For You) If two pieces need a top to complete the outfit it is not necessary to have constructed the top. The outfit must be a complete wearable outfit. **Night shirts, flannel lounging pants or loungewear cannot be modeled.** However, if there is only one constructed garment and it needs another piece or more to be complete it **must** be entered in Make One/Buy One.

- C410090 COAT / OUTERWEAR / JACKET – Can be lined or unlined, non-tailored – (Sewing For You)
- C410100 TAILORING: BLAZER or SUIT JACKET or COAT – must be worn as a complete wearable outfit. Additional pieces with blazer, jacket or coat may either be constructed or purchased. (Tailoring)
- C410120 SHOPPING IN STYLE – modeled purchased outfit – SF184 must be entered into the Extension Office by the appropriate deadline date, see Deadlines, Dates and Identifications.
- C410902 CLOTHING LEVEL 1
- C410903 SEWING FOR FUN - Can only be modeled at the public style show - items will not be judged for modeling and 4-H'ers can model only one time. No pin cushions or needle books may be modeled. (Multi-color premium only).
- C410904 MAKE ONE/BUY ONE - (anyone in Clothing Level II, Sewing For You, Tailoring, Crochet or Knitting) are eligible to model one outfit in this class.
- C410905 RECYCLED– Any garment (anyone in Clothing Level II, Sewing For You, Tailoring, Crochet or Knitting) are eligible to model one outfit in this class.
- C410906 SEWN and WORN – Any garment (anyone in Clothing Level II, Sewing For You, Tailoring, Crochet or Knitting) are eligible to model one outfit in this class.
- C410907 ATTENTION SHOPPERS! – modeled purchase garment(s)
- C410908 MODELING FOR FUN - Extra **clothing garments** constructed for General Sewing classes (Clothing Level I, Decorate Your Duds, Clothing Level II, Sewing For You, Tailoring, Crochet or Knitting). Also includes night shirts, flannel lounging pants or loungewear.
- C410909 FCS WORKSHOP ITEMS ONLY.
- C410910 JR CLOVER MODELING – FCS Workshop items only.
